TB Risk Assessment Test: Alaska law requires a TB Risk Assessment be on file for all students new to the Copper River School District. If the results of the TB Risk Assessment warrant, a TB skin test will be required within 90 days of enrollment.

An exemption for testing is permitted if documentation of one of the following is provided to your School Nurse:

1. TB skin test results within the previous 6 months
2. history of positive skin test or history of TB disease
